

2024 B-HOBBY RULES

ALL RULES LISTED IN GENERAL ALSO APPLY TO THIS DIVISION

Visual protest must be done at least fifteen (15) minutes before feature.

Body.

- American rear wheel drive only
- Steel or aluminum stock style bodies.
- Minimum wheelbase 108"
- Car must have a floor pan under the driver's seat made from minimum .060 aluminum or steel.
- 12" spoiler max. No wider than deck lid.
- Late model style sideboards.

Weight.

- Full frame cars minimum 2760 pounds must be on stock rear suspension hook-ups adjustment holes ok.
- Clip cars 2800 pounds + 25 pounds for non-solid top link
- Clip cars must be identified by a sticker available from the track.
- Any car that is fully legal for the Durance Layne Performance Parts Street Stock Division series may race in this division, weighing 3050 pounds.

Wheels.

Steel or aluminum. 14" wide maximum width on any wheel. Beadlocks are permitted.

Tires.

- Open tires on front and left rear.
- Right Rear American Racer MD 56, Hoosier 55, 1600, NLMT 4.
- No chemical treating allowed. Track will take rubber samples at random.

Roll Cage.

- Must have full roll cage with minimum six points welded to frame.
- Must have minimum three driver side door bars and minimum three bars in passenger door
- Must have crossbar behind driver for proper positioning of seat belt harness

Suspension/Steering.

- Stock type steering box or racks.
- Center link eliminator ok.
- Solid 3rd link suspension okay optional non solid top link add 25 pounds
- Oil shocks only all the way around car. 4 shocks total on car.
- Steel body shocks only
- No gas charged of any kind allowed "unless it is a stock type look alike body". No Schrader valve, bulb type, seal screws, turnable knobs, external reservoirs. There's to be no way to access inside of shock.
- No coil overs.
- \$200 buyout rule per shock. Must be on lead lap & running in top 5.
- One shock per wheel.
- Stock appearing springs front and rear (coil or leaf) five-inch minimum coil.
- Leaf springs may run sliders.
- May run adjustable spring buckets or weight jacks.
- May run aftermarket front upper control arm. Front lower control arms must be stock or stock tube type replacement mounted in the original OEM position. Tolerance +/- ½"
- Rear-end mounts must be solid (welded or clamped to the tube) No bird cage style mounts that allow rear-end to rotate or move in any way.
- Rear control arms may be bars with Heims. May be adjustable in length only. Rods must be straight. No spring rods, etc.

Fuel.

- Gas or E-85 only. No alcohol, no nitrous oxide, no other fuel additives. Fuels must have a specific gravity of .745 gas/E-85 .786. Anything over will be illegal.
- Fuel Cell –All fuel cells MUST be mounted inside a 20-gauge metal box supported by two (2) 1/8 x 2" steel straps mounted inside the protective structure of the vehicle.

Transmission.

- Any type of dirt racing transmission.
- Automatic or straight shift.
- Automatic must have working torque converter.
- No direct drive. No valve pedals.
- Mini clutch is allowed.
- Disc brakes are permitted.
- Any brake calipers

Rear End.

- Quick change rear ends allowed.
- 9-inch Ford floater type rear end ok

Engine.

- Engine Setback Rule --# 1 plug in line with upper ball joint
- 362 cubic inch maximum
- Headers allowed
- Any intake. No porting.
- Any carburetor.
- Any 23-degree head allowed. Must be steel. No porting, polishing. + or 1 degree
- No raised runner heads
- No modifications. No exceptions.
- May be cut for screw in studs and guide plates
- Any valve
- Any rocker arm or stud girdles.
- May run larger diameter than stock valve springs.
- ARP head bolts are permitted.
- No mushroom lifters allowed.
- Any cam
- Flat top pistons only. Zero deck minimum. Must have rings in minimum 3 grooves. No gas ports allowed.
- Crank must be a minimum of 48 pounds including crank gear. GM stroke is 3.480"
- Ford stroke 3.500
- No 400 blocks
- No destroking
- OEM cast iron blocks only
- No bowtie or aftermarket blocks allowed.
- May bore block and use ARP main bolts and oil screens.
- Any steel rod
- No part of the piston may produce above the deck of the block
- May run aftermarket oil pans. Steel pans only.
- Stock style oil pump.

Protest Fees.

- All protest procedures can be found in general rules
- \$500 -- Complete tear down. Intake to oil pan
- \$250 -- Pull head
- \$50 Pull Valve Cover
- Track Retains 30%

Miscellaneous.

Raceceivers are MANDATORY at ALL times a race car is on the track. Any driver without an operating raceceiver
on their person will be sent to the pits. No exceptions.

 Transponders are MANDATORY during heat races, qualifying and/or features. Any car rolling onto the track without a transponder will be sent to the pits.

Safety.

• All safety rules listed in the General Rules, Safety, will apply here. No exceptions. It is your responsibility to comply with all rules.
